Being the speech delivered by Pastor Adeniyi Faboya, at RCCG Praise City

Parish (01/09/2019).

The Message was titled "The Righteous Will Flourish" from the Scripture Psalm 92 verse 12-15. OR "The Promise of The Righteous"; which was defined as "One who has wilfully repented of his sin and accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Saviour". No one is righteous outside Jesus, according to Philippians 3:9.

There are those whose righteousness is derived of God. We are righteous through Christ. The Bible is full of God's promises, a declaration that something will or will not be done.

Psalm 37:26 says "I have never see the righteous forsaken - - - - Isaiah 3:10 – Tell the righteous, it is well with you. Proverb

One even confronted him about it. But when he told them his hand to mouth struggle in life, their countenances about him changed.

Before Success; there comes work, there comes struggle, there comes effort, but out of the effort and the work come the experience; the upbuilding, the development, the capacity to understand and sympathize; the greatest heritage that can come to a man. And nothing in the world can give that to a man, so that it will burn into him, as will the struggle of life. The end result of the efforts, of the struggle is the success that will be attained.

Today, I'm discussing with you the topic; **May Your Way Be Rough**. May your way to the building of your Temple of Success in life be rough.

The beginning of your life when you were born is the beginning of your journey of life. It ends when you die. In between, you either make your mark or you don't. Success is attained when you make your mark in life, and that happened when you have happiness, harmony and peace of mind.

Of the three, only Wealth is absolutely within our control; good health depends on your hereditary genes, your choosing life-style and the gift of God on your life. Becoming a Success is not accidental nor is it coincidental; but is intentional and effort oriented. You must desire to be one, which means it cannot be forced on you.

It is also a movement, that is, it is ongoing and is not a monument which means historical.

It is better to be a stakeholder where you belong to the club and not an onlooker which means belonging to the committee of failures. So be a stake-holder and not an onlooker.

To be a success and be wealthy depends on you and your desire. If you desire to be rich, you can become rich, only you have to desire it, works towards it through efforts, backed with plans and execution. To plan without execution becomes a wishful thinking. So, becoming a success in life is a journey that is not completed in one day.

It is only then that your desire can be achieved, your harmony attained and your happiness secured.

Dreams are real and we all we all dream dreams. Between your dream and destiny, there is a roadmap which you have to activate or workout to bring your dream to reality and manifestation.

This roadmap is infested with ups and downs, hardships and frustrations which we refer to as struggle or what is called circumstances of life.

Believe me, circumstances of life rarely favour the optimist. Circumstances of life seems to favour those who preferred to be pampered, but mark it, these are those that end up becoming a puppet in life.

To be a success you MUST go through the struggle of life and this is unconditional nor is it optional. Watch it, if your life's journey is too smooth, for such hardly end up in good story; So, May Your Way Be Rough in life.

Each individual is the Builder of his own Temple of success and at the same time, you are the stone to be used for your Temple and which must pass through the Quarry of Life for the stone to be fit for Master's use. A quarry is a site for mining stone or slate.

I believe in struggle as a condition to experience, to go through, and then to get out of it and not a condition to stay in. To get out of it, you must have it as your purpose to get out of.

This is the first essential; to get out of the struggle. A purpose. Then the purpose must be backed with effort and willingness to work and to work at anything that comes your way. Whatever it is, as long as it is the way out.

That is using every rung in the ladder as a rung to the one above it.

It means effort, but out of the effort and the work come the experience; the up-building, the development; the capacity to understand and sympathize, the greatest heritage that can come to you. Nothing in the world can give you that burning in you as will a struggle.

So I'm telling you now; struggle is the greatest blessing in the way of the deepest and fullest experience that can come to you, but I repeat, always as a condition to be in and to work out but NEVER to stay in.

The editor I mentioned at the introduction was truly a successful Journalist. He did not become a success overnight, but rather, paid the price because there is no success without sacrifice. Nobody makes a mark in the world without bleeding.

He was six years old when his father lost his means and failed to find his place in the world. He was the first of two boys and the family migrated to an English-speaking country and thus he had the handicap of growing up in an environment where he knew no word of the English language. The boys were cruel, as boys are, and the teachers were impatient.

After school hours for the boys was not to play but to go home and help mother who daily grew more frail under the burden of lack and no money. This went on for years.

At ten, he got his first job, washing the windows of a baker's shop for peanut as wages. In a week or two he was allowed to sell bread and cakes behind the counter after school hours for five dollars a week – handing out freshly baked cakes and warm, delicious-smelling bread to customers when scarcely a crumb has passed his mouth that day.

Then on Saturday mornings, he served a route for a weekly paper and sold his remaining stock on the street. This meant one dollar for that day's work.

He later graduated to a more lucrative business of supplying drinking water to motorist at a cent a glass and this brings two or three dollars for the Saturday's work.

This later became five dollars a day when he began to squeeze lemon into his water and the liquid became lemonade.

From this, he became a reporter during the evening, an office boy at day-time and learned stenography at night.

His story was made known for the first time when he responded to a claim by one of his readers that he was a theorist, writing articles that seek to preach economy or that reflect a hand-to-hand struggle on a small income. An experience he knew nothing about.

He was quick to let it be known that there is not a single step, not an inch, on the road of direct poverty that he did not know or had not experienced.

IF YOU MEET A MAN WHO SAYS HE IS WISE AND HAS NOT GONE THROUGH HARDSHIP; ASK HIM TO BRING OUT HIS TEACHER.

Every thought, every feeling and every experience of hardship that come in the way of a struggling man is a lesson and the school preparing him for higher responsibility for that man and all those that are travelling along that road.

It is unfortunate that we see some people travelling along that road without having learn any lesson at all. Such are billed to repeat the class.

Unpleasant situations must surely come our ways in our journey of life toward success; but woe unto him who fails to learn the lesson of life that is being revealed, for it is but a spark that require a combustible object for it to become the light.

Spark the match and if there is no candle as the combustible object to brighten your life, the spark of light dies off. Your effort or your struggle is the combustion to keep your light burning. May your way be rough, I repeat.

Again, Nature has arranged the affairs of mankind so that every person who comes into the age of reason must bear the cross of FAILURE in one form or another.

This brings me to the issue of what is called 'Midlife Crisis'. A midlife crisis is a transition of identity and self-confidence that can occur in middle-aged individuals, typically 45 to 65 years old. It last between 3-10 years in men and 2-5 years in women.

Caused by aging, problems, changes or regrets over works or marriages or lack of any of these and so many other challenges that are inevitable to occur in our lives.

Some never survive it and it has been discovered that these are those that allows it to overwhelm them. In life, unpleasant circumstances will spring up it's ugly head, it is how you handle it that will determine its effect on you. Those that survive it are mainly those that have smoothened their rough roads to their temple of Success. They simply say; we've passed this road before and survived, so they move on.

A river runs from its source to the sea, along its path are hard soils and soft ones. When the river encountered a hard soil, it mingles round it, find the soft path and go its way. When there is no soft soil, it goes over the hard soil and finds its way or become a flood. That is human life for you. Go round your challenges and never allows it to become the obstacle to your destiny.

Your road will definitely be rough, but each time unpleasant situation occurs, face it headlong and resolve it, it gives you the experience to handle the next one that would surely come. You will soon become the expert that others, particularly the young ones, could approach for wisdom. You can only counsel an experience you had encountered or overcame. If I need to borrow a dress from you, I need to see the one that you put on.

May your way be rough; for it is the path to get to your destiny.
